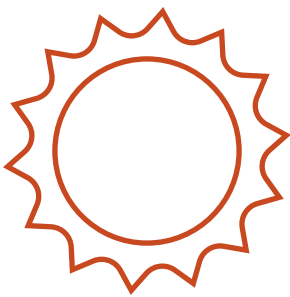

Without traditional forced-air heating or air-conditioning systems, your passive house apartment performs 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to ensure that your home is always comfortable.

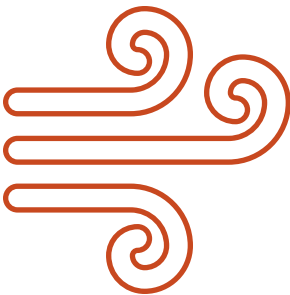
THESE TIPS CAN HELP YOU TO MAXIMIZE THE BENEFITS OF YOUR PASSIVE HOUSE APARTMENT.



SUN SHY

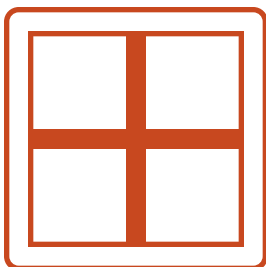
Your home does most of the work – exterior awnings on the south side of the building and triple-paned windows keep the extreme summer sun at bay. On extra hot days, be sure to close your window shades during daylight hours for maximum comfort.

South-facing Windows? Use your floor-to-ceiling sunshades on hot days to help the entire building remain temperate.



AIR APPARENT

During the day, keep your windows closed – the building's HRV system will bring in fresh, filtered air all day long. Each apartment is equipped with a ceiling fan so you can enjoy a cool breeze without introducing hot outside air.

Take advantage of Portland's breezy summer nights to cool off your apartment in the evening. Your European tilt-turn windows are fully operable.
