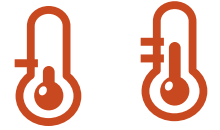

Without traditional forced-air heating or air-conditioning systems, your passive house apartment performs 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to ensure that your home is always comfortable.

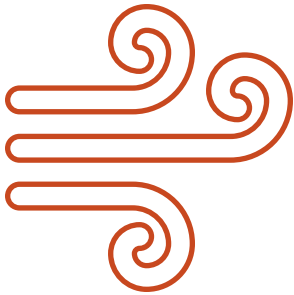
THESE TIPS CAN HELP YOU TO MAXIMIZE THE BENEFITS OF YOUR PASSIVE HOUSE APARTMENT.



MORE PANE. MORE GAIN.

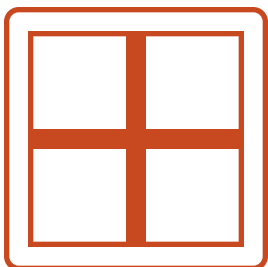
Generously sized, triple-paned windows capture every stray ray in the winter, taking full advantage of the sun's heat. Be sure to open up your window shades during the day, especially when the sun comes out.

South-facing Windows? In the winter, open up your window shades during the day to maximize solar gain and help heat the entire building.



FRESH AIR

Let the fresh in, leave the cold out. The building's HRV system is always on, working to bring in outside air and bring it to room temperature before delivering it to your apartment.



COZY UP

Thick, insulated walls and triple-paned windows ensure that heat stays in, even in your favorite spot by the window. Your apartment is also equipped with a quiet hydroponic radiant panel heater, bringing coziness to every nook and cranny.
